Call For Submission

Artcite's Annual DOING THE LOUVRE big Holiday Show and Sale

Members are invited to submit works for sale at no charge, non-members are requested to pay a \$15 submission fee.

Dates: Show opens December 4 and runs through December 24

Drop-off starts Tuesday November 24, 1-6pm through Saturday November 30, then on Tuesday December 1 again until 6pm. Please note that we are closed Sunday and Monday.

Eligibility: Open to Windsor/ Southwestern Ontario area and Detroit Area artists.

Exhibition Requirements: Paintings, drawings, prints, photographs (or a combination of these media), small scale 3-D works and artist made gift items (books, toys, cards, 'art wear', accessories, etc.) all will be exhibited. 2-D works do not have to be framed, but MUST be ready for hanging; framed and heavy and /or fragile wall works that do not have solid, well attached hardware for safe and secure hanging will not be accepted.

Works are accepted on a first-come-first-served basis, and hung gallery style. (floor to near-ceiling) Placement decisions made by the hanging crew are final; though we try to accommodate special requests should the works require it.

A maximum of 10 works per artist will be accepted.

Total combined dimension of each work should not exceed 36" by 36" (3 sq. Ft.); 3-D works must fit within a 36" cube.

Multiples (e.g. 20 identical (or near) postcards, priced the same) count as one work, and will be restocked as they sell.

All Entries must be Sale Priced \$99.99 or Less (Hint: "less" usually sells more art...)

For this special fundraising event only, Artcite's commission fee is 30% for artworks sold.

All entries must be accompanied by a \$15.00 handling fee (fee waived for current Artcite Members) and be clearly identified with artist's name, address and telephone number, title, medium and sale price of work.

Works accepted will be insured by Artcite during the exhibition ONLY:

Due to restriction of storage space, Artcite cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to unsold works not picked up by at least a week after the show closing.

Call for Submission - Healing through Art: Timeless Transitions—An eternity in a single moment

Submission Deadline: Tuesday January 12, 2010, 3pm—7pm

Who can enter: The exhibition is open to all amateur and professional artists except those participating in the judging and their immediate families. Financial assistance for artists is available. For criteria and to apply contact Nneka Allen at 255-9940 x225.

What can be entered? Open to BLACK & WHITE, ONE DIMENSIONAL ART (painting, mixed media and digital images). **Size must not exceed 48”x 32” in size and 50lbs in weight.**

A maximum of two (2) entries may be submitted. Art series will be accepted up to a maximum of three in a series. Artists must attach a contact card and price (if for sale), please attach to the **back of the art piece and on your artist’s statement.**

When you can enter All entries must be submitted to 1400 Windsor Ave. on Tuesday January 12, 2010 between 3pm and 7pm. For information call Nneka Allen at 255-9940 x225. Entries will not be accepted prior to this date & time or after the 7pm deadline.

How to enter **Artists must include an “Artist’s Statement” relating to the theme, Healing Through Art: “Timeless Transitions”. If possible, please provide your artist’s statement in hard copy and electronic format. Please include complete contact information on your artist’s statement as well as the price of your artwork, if it is for sale. Please limit your artists statement to 300 characters. Clearly label each entry with YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, E-MAIL and the TITLE of the art piece (or untitled) on the back of the artwork. (Art will be disqualified if this information is not provided) Art work must be ready to hang or ready for installation. Please include hanging and installation instructions to ensure your artwork is displayed properly. (diagrams highly recommended) Please note that the Exhibition will be displayed in a dedicated space and should be submitted ready to hang. Please bring art wrapped to ensure protection in transport. Please DO NOT wrap art with tape, please use string.**

Judging and notification The Leamington Arts Centre will host the Juried Art Exhibition from March 1 - 24, 2010.

Artists will be contacted by January 29, 2010 regarding the results of the jury process. All selected artwork will remain in the possession of CMHA-WECB until the end of the exhibition tour March 24, 2010. All art must be picked up no later than March 29, 2010.

A volunteer will call artists to schedule a time for the pick up of unselected art.

And finally... Selected artists are invited to attend the exhibition and reception to represent their artwork. Please contact Nneka Allen to reserve your ticket in advance. Up to two complimentary tickets will be provided to each artist selected to participate in the exhibition.
